Zibi Ontario – Chaudière Island (Blocks 205A, 206, 207, and 208)
The Zibi development involves three islands on the Ontario side
(Chaudière Island East, Chaudière Island West, and Albert Island).
The site is being redeveloped from an industrial paper mill plant
into a mixed use residential development. The development and
design philosophy follows the One Planet guidelines that pays
homage to the site's cultural and spiritual importance, its past
history and use, and strives for modern energy reduction and
minimize carbon footprint.

Block 205A is a 6-storey residential building with retail on the ground floor and achieved LEED Gold certification; Block 206 is a high rise residential building with retail on the ground floor; Block 207 is a mid rise office building with retail on the ground floor; and Block 208 is a low rise commercial building that will contain the existing components.
